Downtown Joliet Lift Bridge Maintenance to Begin Monday,  
October 10, 2011

**Joliet, IL – The City of Joliet:** Beginning Monday, October 10, 2011, all Downtown Joliet lift bridges will be experiencing periodic lane closures due to IDOT maintenance.

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) will be performing maintenance in the form of washing the bridges located in Downtown Joliet, beginning Monday, October 10. The maintenance work is scheduled to conclude by October 21, 2011. Lift bridges located at: McDonough Street, Jefferson Street, Cass Street, Jackson Street and Ruby Street will all be subject to lane closures during this period.

There will be no detours posted during this maintenance. Motorists should anticipate daily lane closures in the designated bridge areas.
