Joliet Parkway Tree Trimming and Removal Notice

Joliet, IL – The City of Joliet: As part of city wide seasonal preparation, the City of Joliet Forestry Division along with the assistance of the Public Works Department are currently elevating and trimming parkway trees. City staff will also continue to remove Ash trees less than 10” in diameter that are located in the parkway in response to the Emerald Ash Bore problem.

-Trimming will occur on all parkway trees or branches that are obstructing stop signs, street lights or interfering with mailboxes and fire hydrants.

- Ash trees to be removed as part of the City’s Emerald Ash Bore Plan include those obstructing stop signs and street lights and/or interfering with mailboxes and fire hydrants. The ash trees being removed may or may not be infested but are being removed in response to the EAB Plan. The trees being removed will not be replaced.
