DETAILS:

Rates for the new parking meter systems will be recalibrated to accommodate capital improvement projects in the areas of safety and maintenance for the parking facilities.

AFFECTIVE LOCATIONS/ FEES:

Parking Meters located in “Zone A” will charge \$1/hour as of 5/10/10.

[This includes the area south of Cass Street/Route 30 and north of Washington Street railroad tracks between Joliet Street and Mayor Art Schultz Drive]

Parking Meters located in “Zone B” will be \$0.50/hour as of 5/10/10.

[This area is located south of Jackson Street and north of Cass Street, between Joliet and Scott Street; as well as, the area south of Cass Street and north of Jefferson Street between N. Eastern Avenue and Mayor Art Schultz Drive.]

Pay-and-Display spaces located in the “Barrett’s Lot” will be \$1/hour as of 5/10/10.

[This area is located south of Van Buren Street and north of Jefferson Street between Joliet Street and Ottawa Street.]

Pay-and-Display spaces located in the “Union Station Lot” will be \$1/hour as of 5/10/10.

[This area is located directly west of Joliet’s Union Station; south of Jefferson Street, north of Washington Street between Scott Street and the Will County Court House.]

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Monitoring of parking lots and metered areas are enforced Monday – Friday 8am – 5pm and Saturday 8am – 1pm. All parking areas are FREE to the public on Sunday and after 5pm daily.

VIOLATION FEES:

Fines for parking violations are: Parking Lot violations: \$30; Meter/Pay Station violations: \$10; Fire Hydrant/Fire Lane violations: \$75.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Joliet will be converting parking meters on the streets throughout the city. In addition, the city will also be installing new automated pay-and-display stations in the “Union Station Lot” eliminating the use of individual meters in the lot. The new pay-and-display stations in the “Union Station Lot” will allow motorists to park and pay via credit card at an hourly rate for an unlimited amount of time as indicated on site. In addition, this new pay-and-display parking system will be in affect at the parking located behind McBrody’s Bar & Grill known as the “Barrett’s Lot”.

The City of Joliet continues to make every effort to notify commuters and motorists of the updated parking meter system in the next month. Plans include on site signage, mass media awareness campaign, as well as utilizing the web site, partner e-mail distribution lists and area social marketing networks.
