The ordinance providing for a Historical Preservation Commission was enacted on September 19, 1990. Applicants are urged to read the full ordinance #9296 (27pp) and the amendment to it #9497 (3pp). Both are on file at the Joliet Public Library at the reference desk. Ask for the "Preservation Ordinance". City Hall also has copies.

Historic Preservation Commissioners are appointed by the Mayor, approved by the City Council and serve for three years. The Commission meets on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 7:00 in the East wing conference room of the Municipal Building, 150 W. Jefferson St. Joliet, IL. Commissioners also serve on committees where much of the commission's work is accomplished.

Below is a section from the ordinance describing the basis on which a commissioner is selected. Please indicate which area best describe your area of expertise, experience or interest.

The voting members of the commission shall be residents of the City of Joliet and shall be appointed on the basis of demonstrated expertise, experience or interest in the area of anthropology, architecture, art, building construction, engineering, finance, historical and architectural preservation, history, law, community development, planning, real estate and related professions.
