

ORDINANCE NO. 9457

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the Historic Preservation Commission as created in September of 1990 would function more effectively with the addition of two voting members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOLIET, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 8-603(a) of Division 2 of the Historic Preservation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 9296) is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

(a) There is hereby created the Historic Preservation Commission which shall consist of nine voting members to be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council. The initial members shall serve staggered terms as determined by lots drawn at the first regular meeting of the commission, three members to serve for one year, three members to serve for two years, and three members to serve for three years. As each initial term expires, appointments shall be made for full terms of three years and until the respective successor of each member is appointed. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment for the remainder of an unexpired term. Members shall serve without compensation.

SECTION 2: The first sentence of Section 8-604(c) of Division 2 of the Historic Preservation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 9296) is amended to read as follows:

(c) A quorum shall consist of five voting members.

SECTION 3: The first sentence of Section 8-609 of Division 4 of the Historic Preservation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 9296) is amended to read as follows:

The commission, by six affirmative votes of its members then holding office of any person, group of persons, or association may apply for landmark, historic district, or urban conservation district designation for property and improvements located within the corporate limits of the City of Joliet.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be deemed separable and the invalidity of any section, clause, paragraph, sentence or provision of the Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same, are hereby repealed, except as otherwise provided in this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and recording according to law.
